It would require some weeding and occasional watering, plus planting if anyone has spare suitable plants at home. Work has completed on the renovation of the path around Chapel Meadow. This has been delayed for a number of months due to the wet weather, as under those conditions the works would have caused a great deal of damage to the path and surrounding areas. It is hoped that the path will now be much easier to navigate for visitors to the meadow, and particularly for those who use mobility aids. However, please note that further works will begin on the meadow this autumn, as part of an ongoing programme of woodland management and improvement.

The Parish Council secured a grant to replace the seesaw on Burnside play area. A traditional style was chosen as the existing seesaw appeared to be a popular choice and the new one is now in place for children to enjoy.
