Parbold Parish Council Chairman Cllr Arnold met again with Borough Councillors Katie Juckes, David Whittington and Ashley Dalton MP to walk Ms Dalton through the affected flooding areas and show her the extent of the issue. There will be a drop in event at Ormskirk Civic Hall on Thursday 6th March between 3.30pm and 7.30pm in support of people who have experienced flooding to their homes, businesses or land, or are concerned about it. Plans are also afoot to hold a meeting in Parbold on the morning of 6th, to discuss the flooding issues relating just to Parbold.

The existing Parbold Parish Maps frame situated on the bridge on Mill Lane had rusted and the contents were water damaged and difficult to read. Both the frame and poster have now been replaced, so that walkers and visitors can easily view all the footpaths around Parbold and enjoy the village and surrounding countryside.

Councillors have recently been pushing for the completion of the tow path renovation between the Alder Lane and Mill Lane bridges. Work is now underway and should greatly improve this well used section of the tow path.
